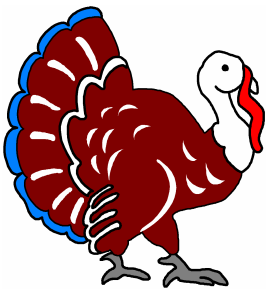

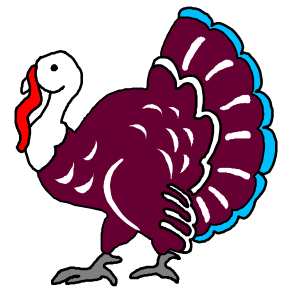

# TURKEY DAY RELAYS 2003 RACE INFO

## ENTRY FORMS AND PROCEDURES:

- No telephone entries
- No fax entries
- No e-mail entries
- Each Member of a relay team must completely fill out an entry form, and sign the risk waiver
- Pick up entry forms at Beaver Sports, Raven Cross Country, or at the Warming Hut at Birch Hill
- Entries may be dropped off at Beaver Sports or at Raven Cross Country
- Entries will be picked up Monday, November 24 (early fees) at 5:00pm, and Wednesday, November 26 (late fees) at 5:00pm. No forms may be dropped off at any location after 5:00pm on Wednesday
- Entry forms and fees may be mailed to the Nordic Ski Club of Fairbanks at:

- Mailed entries must be received by Tuesday, November 25.
- School or University Teams or Clubs entering 3 or more relay teams should contract race director (474-4244) for group entry details.

## ENTRY DEADLINES AND FEES:

- **EARLY ENTRY:**
  - To qualify for early entry fees, **both** forms and fees must be **received** not later than 5:00pm, Monday, November 24
  - Grades K-8 pay \$5/person  
High School and older pay \$10/person
- **LATE ENTRY:**
  - When **both** forms and fees are **received** between 5:00pm, Monday, November 24 and 5:00pm, Wednesday, November 26:
    - Grades K-8 pay \$10/person  
High School and older pay \$15/person
- **RACE DAY ENTRY:**
  - Race day entry closes at 10:30am for ALL classes, with NO exceptions.
  - Grades K-8 pay \$30/team; \$15/individual  
High School and older pay \$50/team; \$20/individual
  - NOTE: Individuals who have sent in entry forms but not yet paid their entry fee will pay race day fees
  - Bib pickup closes at 12:00pm for all high school and adult classes. There will be no exceptions to this policy.

## CLASSES

- Within each scholastic class or age class there is competition in a girls'/women's class and in a combining boys'/men's teams and mixed teams
- Scholastic class is determined by the highest class of any member of the team
  - Scholastic Classes:
    - grades K-1-2 and grades 3-4 go 3 x 1km
    - grades 5-6 and grades 7-8 go 3 x 2km
    - HS teams go 3 x 5km with the adults
- Adult Classes are determined by the age of the youngest member of the team
- If any individual on a team does not provide Date of Birth, the team will be entered in the open class
- Adult Classes (all go 3 x 5km)
  - Open (born 1974 or later) women, men/mixed
  - 30-39 (born 1964-1973) women, men/mixed
  - 40-49 (born 1954-1963) women, men/mixed
  - 50+ (born 1953 and before) women, men/mixed

## RULES

1. Teams consist of three individuals – there is no solo class
2. Teams of less than three will not be list in results, nor are they eligible for awards
3. Skiers who ski more than one leg must pay an entry fee for each leg they ski

# NORDIC SKI CLUB OF FAIRBANKS --2003 TURKEY DAY RELAYS

## Acknowledgement and Assumption of Risk and Release

Please read this risk waiver carefully before signing. Entry into NSCF Turkey Day Relays races is permitted only for those competitors who have valid risk waivers signed by themselves and, where the competitor is under 18, signed also by their parent or guardian.

In consideration of the rights and privileges associated with participation in the Turkey Day Relays cross country ski races held November 28, 2003 and sponsored by the Nordic Ski Club of Fairbanks, I agree and acknowledge to be bound by the following:

- 1. Identification of Risks.** I understand that preparation for and participation cross country skiing, competitions (“the Activity”) involves of risks of serious injury, including permanent disability, death, and other losses, both to me and my property. I understand that these injuries and losses might result not only from my actions, but from the actions, inaction, or negligence of others. Inherent dangers and risks include, for example, weather conditions such as wind and cold resulting in frostbite, existing and changing snow conditions, collisions with natural and man-made objects and other skiers, variation in terrain and the failure of skiers to ski within their own ability and physical fitness levels.
- 2. Assumption of the Risk.** I agree that I am responsible for my safety while participating in the Activity, and that such responsibility includes participating in the Activity only: a) when I am both physically and psychologically prepared to participate safely, b) after fully familiarizing myself with the venue before beginning the Activity, including the weather and snow conditions, race course layout and obstacles that a visual inspection would have revealed, and c) while using the equipment of a type and condition reasonably necessary to safely participate in the Activity. I assume all risks connected with responsibility for any injury or loss connected with my participation in the Activity.
- 3. Waiver.** Aware of the risks and willing to assume them, I hereby waive, release, and hold harmless the Nordic Ski Club of Fairbanks and the Fairbanks North Star Borough and each of those organization’s affiliates, subsidiaries, officers, directors, employees, agents, coaches, trainers, doctors, officials, event organizers or sponsors (“Released Parties”) from all claims by me for any liability, injury, loss or damage in any way connected with my participation in the Activity, except where caused by gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct of any of the Released Parties. I intend for this waiver and release to also apply to any relatives, personal representatives, heirs, beneficiaries, next of kin or assigns who might pursue any legal action or claim on my behalf.
- 4. Applicable Law.** This waiver and release informed under and is to be interpreted consistent with laws of the State of Alaska.
- 5. Insurance.** I currently have, and agree to maintain throughout the time that I participate, valid and sufficient medical and accident coverage. I understand that this is my sole responsibility and release all persons and entities from providing this coverage for me.
